2nd Quran Competition

Juz Amma Memorisation (Kids, Girls- 5 to 15 yrs old)

Judging Criteria

- Participants will be marked on the Memorisation,
- Extra marks for application of rules of Tajweed,
- Extra marks for application of rules for Stopping and Beginning of verses,
- Extra marks for voice and tune application if applied.

For applying Tajweed and Stopping/Beginning correctly, participants are encouraged to repeatedly listen to recitations of Ustad Khalil Al-Hussary.

For Voice and Tune, participants can listen repeatedly to recitations of Ustad Mishari bin Rashed Alafasy and Ustad Muhammad Siddiq al-Minshawi.

Format

- Questions will be asked from the beginning of the ayah.
- Connection between surahs and connection of ayahs from left page onto the right page of the Holy Quran, and vice versa, will be tested.



Age Categories

There are three levels for memorization Competition. Please select one of the age groups listed below.

- 1- Memorisation of Surah At-Takathur to Surah An-Nas (age group 5 7)
- 2- Memorisation of Surah Al-Fajr to Surah At-Takathur (age group 8 11)
- 3- Memorisation of Surah An- Naba to Surah Adh-Dhuha (age group 12 16)

Rules of Registration in RAB Competitions

- Participation is open to girls only.
- Complete the registration form on the website according to the information of your ID card or passport. Registration of all details is mandatory and incomplete registration will result in cancellation of the competition.
- The only way for the competition headquarters to communicate with the competitors will be through WhatsApp messenger and email, so candidates must register a valid email and WhatsApp number.
- We will send you a confirmation email after your registration, so there is no need to register more than once. If you did not receive the confirmation email after 24 hours, you can contact us via WhatsApp.

Rules of Participation in RAB Online Competitions

- Since the competitions are held online, esteemed candidates are required to have the necessary facilities such as high-speed internet, smart phone or laptop and headphones to participate in the virtual test.
- Using a mobile phone is not different from a laptop and is up to the participant. But the mobile phone needs to be set horizontally and steadily. The face of the performer should be completely clear. It is necessary for the image and



the sound to have sufficient clarity. Girls should cover their hair and avoid wearing a face niqab).

- All participants should watch the video on how to access the online competition room and share their video and voice only when their name is called.
- Note that on the day of the competition, connecting your video and voice while others are reciting will distract them and will get you negative points.
- Participants should introduce themselves at the beginning of their recitation as follows: First and last name, age, country, and city.
- Note that it is necessary to be in a quiet room without the presence of anyone and try to avoid any other disturbances. If there are two people from the same house, they should not sit next to each other in one single room.
- A technical check is available one day before the time of the online competitions.
